

Dear parents

As the term finally draws to a close I wanted to firstly thank everybody for their support and patience during this difficult time and also once again for the support you gave to the children during home schooling.

The children have made great progress this term and we are all very excited about being able to return to normal in September. This will mean that most of the restrictions currently in place will be lifted. Children will come into school at 8.50 and play in the playground until 9.00, at which point they will file into classes and begin their day. School will finish at 3.15 for all children, where they can be collected from the school gate unless walking home themselves.

Arrangements will be slightly different for Reception during the first couple of weeks, but parents will be advised about this separately.

Lunch times and break times will be mixed and they will be able to play with friends. We will return to the previous assemblies, the first of those being Harvest Assembly in October. After school clubs will also resume and letters will go out in due course.

Cleaning and hand washing will continue and the classrooms will be ventilated as much as possible. As the weather becomes cooler, please ensure that jumpers or cardigans are available for the children.

Obviously the above arrangements are subject to change, if Government guidelines dictate, but we are very hopeful that this will not be the case.
